# Home School Agreement

<b>Being ready for school Attendance/punctuality</b>	<p>Ensure our child attends regularly and is punctual. Collect our child on time. Park safely with due regard for the neighbours. Avoid taking holidays during term time. Inform the school straight away if our child is absent and send an explanatory note on return to school. Ensure our child wears the school uniform and has his/her PE kit. Name all articles of clothing and water bottles.</p>	<p>Go to bed on time and eat only fruit or vegetables at morning play to help keep me healthy. Drink regularly using my water bottle and water fountains. Remember to take my water bottle home. Wear a sun hat and sunscreen when it is hot. Be on time for lessons. Go straight to the adult who is picking me up at the end of the day. Wear my uniform smartly. Make sure I have my PE kit.</p>	<p>Include healthy lifestyles and well-being in our education programmes. Provide water bottles for all the children. Using the current national initiative, provide fruit/vegetables for children in Reception, Yr 1 &amp; 2 to establish "Healthy Eating" routines. Ensure only fruit &amp; vegetables are eaten at morning play. Monitor the drop off and pick up of the children. Inform parents if children do not have their PE kit.</p>
<b>Supporting learning</b>	<p>Support our child in learning out of school in whatever way we can. Ensure that books/ resources brought home from school are looked after. Attend Parent /Teacher consultations and other meetings arranged specifically for our child. Ensure our child has sufficient sleep and encourage a healthy lifestyle. Ensure our child has the appropriate clothing to enable them to go out at playtime.</p>	<p>Do my best in all my work. Learn from my mistakes. Have all that I need for a lesson. Behave in lessons so that everyone can learn. Ask for help when I need it.</p>	<p>Deliver a broad and balanced curriculum appropriate to the age and stage of the children. Encourage excellence and enjoyment in the children's learning. Provide information and suggestions for supporting learning outside school. Involve the children in the learning process. Reward positive attitudes and good role models. Remove children if they are being disruptive.</p>
<b>Behaviour</b>	<p>Support the school's ethos, expectations and rules. Encourage our child to be responsible and independent. Encourage our child to tell an adult if there is a problem with another child or adult in school.</p>	<p>Follow the school rules. Be responsible for my things and my actions. Respect all the things I use in school and the environment. Be polite and respectful. Respect everyone in our school community. Be sensitive to others' feelings.</p>	<p>Ensure the children know &amp; understand the school rules. Encourage and value independence. Give responsibility to pupils whenever possible. Involve the children in decision making where appropriate.</p>
<b>Communication</b>	<p>Read written communication that comes from school and respond if necessary noting deadlines. Contact the school if we have a concern about our child or the school.</p>	<p>Tell an adult if I have a problem and need help. Use appropriate language: no swearing. Give school letters to my mum, dad or carer.</p>	<p>Listen carefully to children &amp; deal with identified problems. Contact parents if we have concern about a child. Provide regular opportunities for parents to meet with the class teacher. Provide a variety of opportunities for parents to come into school. Supply appropriate information to parents.</p>
