We are now half way through the first half term and the staff and children are back in the routine of school. Home School Agreement

Please complete and return asap:

It is essential that forms are checked and completed thoroughly and returned promptly. Ensure all of your details are up to date including mobile and home numbers and home addresses.

If your pack includes a 'Home School Agreement', please take time to read through this with your child and ask them to sign it. This is their agreement to work and play according to the school rules.
