

## SCHOOL UNIFORM

Our school uniform of navy blue and red gives our children a sense of belonging and pride in themselves and the school as well as contributing to the working atmosphere. All children must wear the correct school uniform according to their Key Stage level. Boys must wear the correct winter uniform (red polo shirt or white shirt and tie) depending upon their year group. **Please help your child by naming all items of clothing.**

Please note that trainers may only be worn on the playground or field.

### **Additional uniform requirements for both Key Stage One and Two pupils**

**Further information**

A PE bag is recommended for keeping belongings together on a child's peg in the cloakroom. The bag is to be kept in school during the week and taken home for washing at the weekend. Each class has two timetabled PE lessons a week when the PE kit is required. There may be additional times when it is also required. If a child does not have the necessary clothes for the PE lesson, a letter is sent home to parents conveying the fact that the child has not been able to follow the PE National Curriculum as a result of not having the appropriate clothing. We ask parents to support us in the delivery of the curriculum by ensuring the PE kit is in school for the PE lesson.

**Jewellery**

Children are not allowed to wear jewellery to school except for a watch and one pair of stud earrings. These have to be removed for PE/games lessons, events and clubs. If the stud earrings cannot be removed, then the child must provide tape or Micropore to put over them, in the interests of Health and Safety. The school cannot take responsibility for the above items.

**Hair Styles**

All shoulder length or longer hair needs to be tied back in a hair bobble in the school colours. No extreme or inappropriate hairstyles or coloured hair, eg shaved heads/Mohicans/tramlines or stencils.

**Insurance**

The children's belongings are not covered under the school insurances. Pupil insurance is available and details can be obtained from the school office.

**Lost Property**

Lost Property is collected and kept outside the hall for children to access when searching for a lost item. It is brought to the entrance lobby on Monday, Wednesday and Friday afternoons for parents to further assist their children. Please ensure each item of clothing is named clearly.
